

中華民國童軍「2025 年沙迦第 10 屆國際青年聚會」甄選辦法 (The 10th Sharjah International Scout Gathering)

一、活動名稱：2025 年沙迦第 10 屆國際青年聚會(The 10th Sharjah International Scout Gathering)。

二、主辦單位：世界童軍總部阿拉伯區支援中心、阿拉伯聯合大公國童軍總會。

三、活動地點：阿拉伯聯合大公國 沙迦酋長國。

四、活動日期：2025 年 2 月 8 日至 17 日。

五、活動背景介紹：根據最高委員會成員暨沙迦統治者謝赫蘇丹·賓·穆罕默德·阿勒卡西米博士殿下的指示與願景，沙迦自 2004 年以來，一直慷慨地接待來自世界各地的羅浮童軍。在殿下的支持下，各國童軍總會積極響應這項號召。多年來，沙迦已舉辦了九屆國際童軍聚會，這些活動源於殿下對青年能力的信念，以及對童軍教育和培養能為當地及國際社區作出有效貢獻的領袖的重要作用的認可。

第十屆沙迦國際童軍聚會彰顯了殿下作為沙迦童軍運動贊助人的持續慷慨精神。此次活動將再次邀請來自世界各地的童軍齊聚沙迦，共同探索地道的阿拉伯文化，在友愛的童軍精神下分享經驗，所有參與者將在沙迦酋長國的童軍大帳篷下團結一致。

六、活動目的：

- (一) 加強參與童軍之間的友誼與兄弟情誼，促進經驗與文化的交流，並介紹參與國家的風俗與傳統。
- (二) 培養青年在身體、心智、社會、精神及情感方面的技能與能力。
- (三) 支持童軍活動中的創新，發掘潛能並鼓勵其成長。
- (四) 推廣多元與包容的文化，尊重各種文化，促進社會各階層的和諧共存。
- (五) 介紹阿拉伯聯合大公國的地標，包括其旅遊、環境及文化特色。
- (六) 灌輸正向價值觀，促進自我發現，並培養對家園的忠誠與歸屬感。

七、活動內容：各國青年文化交流、沙迦機構參訪。

八、參加對象與資格：

- (一) 年齡介於 18 至 25 歲(主辦單位規定出生於 2000 年 2 月 8 日至 2007 年 2 月 8 日間)。
- (二) 英語流利並能介紹我國文化遺產與旅遊資源。
- (三) 履行三項登記之羅浮童軍。
- (四) 沙迦童軍協會補助各國一位代表前往沙迦之來回機票與參加費，上限 2000 元美金。本會將視選送人數平均分配該補助款項。

九、報名：

- (一) 一律採取線上報名，報名網址請點擊[此處](https://forms.gle/VHHQCr69d6zun8s7A)或 <https://forms.gle/VHHQCr69d6zun8s7A>。
- (二) 報名參加人員需經甄選合格後，始由童軍總會向阿拉伯地區辦事處推薦報名參加。
- (三) 報名截止為 113 年 12 月 31 日下午 4 時，逾期恕不受理。
- (四) 面試甄選日期預計於 114 年 1 月 4 日下午 2 時於童軍總會 4 樓(臺北市中山區建國北路一段 23 巷 9 號 4 樓)
- (五) 甄選內容包括中英文口試、參與動機及期許，針對我國羅浮童軍現況、青年參與政策、國際處境、永續發展、我國文化遺產與旅遊資源等議題進行即時發表及問答。評分佔比：儀態、談吐(15%)、口語表達、條理與邏輯(20%)、活動目標及議題熟悉程度(30%)、語言能力或其他專業(25%)、其他加分事由(10%)。
- (六) 錄取人數：正取 1 名、備取 1 名。

十、活動說明：

- (一) 參加人員須在 2025 年 2 月 8 日抵達沙迦，9-16 日為活動日，17 日離營。活動期間由主辦單位安排食宿。保險、其他個人支出，以及活動前後之費用則由個人負擔。
- (二) 參加人員需準備各國文化遺產、旅遊資源之簡報、展覽及文化展演，以與各國童軍交流。
- (三) 參加人員將入住帳篷，需自行攜帶睡袋與睡墊。
- (四) 參加人員需提供有效期限需至少到 2025 年 10 月 1 日的護照，主辦國將提供入境阿拉伯聯合大公國之簽證。
- (五) 建議參加人員應具備單獨旅行、適應氣候與文化差異之能力。

十一、代表團成員義務：

- (一) 完成 Safe from Harm 安全與避害訓練。
- (二) 遵守中華民國童軍參加國際性活動代表團團員守則。
- (三) 參與本會所舉辦相關培訓及資料準備。

First Bulletin

The 10th Sharjah International Scout Gathering – Sharjah - (8–17 February 2025)

Introduction

In line with the directives and vision of His Highness Sheikh Dr. Sultan bin Muhammad Al Qasimi, Member of the Supreme Council and Ruler of Sharjah, to host Rover Youth from all over the world on the land of Sharjah as part of his generous patronage, NSOs from all over the world has been responding to this call since 2004. Over the years, nine International Scout Gatherings have been held, driven by His Highness's belief in the capabilities of young people and the vital role of scouting in education and in developing leaders capable of making effective contributions to their local and international communities. These gatherings have continued to grow in success and impact, shaping a generation of leaders who have become integral parts of their NSOs.

In light of His Highness's commitment to the continuity of this enduring light of the scouting movement from Sharjah, which contributes to its global mission, the 10th International Scout Gathering will be held from February 8–17, 2025

This 10th Sharjah International Scout Gathering reflects the continued generosity of His Highness Sheikh Dr. Sultan bin Muhammad Al Qasimi, Patron of the Scout Movement in Sharjah. It will once again bring together scouts from around the world in Sharjah to explore authentic Arab culture and exchange experiences in a fraternal scouting spirit, all under one scouting tent in the Emirate of Sharjah.

Organization:

The Emirates Scout Association, represented by Sharjah Scout Mission, in collaboration with the Arab Scout Region, will oversee the organization and management of the gathering.

Location: United Arab Emirates – Sharjah.

Gathering Schedule:

- **Arrival:** Saturday, February 8, 2025.
- **Program:** From the morning of Sunday, February 9, 2025, to the evening of Sunday, February 16, 2025.
- **Departure:** Monday, February 17, 2025.

General Objectives of the Gathering

1. Strengthen bonds of friendship and brotherhood among the participating scouts, facilitate the exchange of experiences and cultures, and introduce the customs and traditions of the participating countries.
2. Develop the physical, mental, social, spiritual, and emotional skills and abilities of youth.
3. Support innovation in scouting programs, discover talents, and encourage their growth.
4. Promote a culture of diversity and inclusion across all segments of society while respecting various cultures.
5. Introduce the landmarks of the United Arab Emirates, including its tourism, environmental, and cultural aspects.
6. Instill positive values, foster self-discovery, and nurture a spirit of loyalty and belonging to the homeland.

Participants:

- Scout regions around the world will nominate one (1) outstanding rover scout aged 18–25 from each NSO registered within the five scout regions. The Sharjah Scout Mission will cover participation fees and airfare costs for one (1) rover scout, up to a maximum of \$2,000 USD per participant. Below are the maximum numbers of participants from each region:

No.	Region	Maximum Participants from NSOs
1	Arab Scout Region	19 rovers representing member NSOs
2	African Scout Region	25 rovers representing member NSOs
3	Asia-Pacific Scout Region	25 rovers representing member NSOs
4	European Scout Region	25 rovers representing member NSOs
5	Interamerican Scout Region	10 rovers representing member NSOs

- For those wishing to increase the number of participants at their own expense, they should contact the Emirates Scout Association (Sharjah Scout Mission) to obtain the necessary approvals.
- If airfare costs exceed the specified maximum of \$2,000 USD per participant, the participant should book their ticket independently and will be reimbursed for the specified amount upon arrival in Sharjah.

Registration

Electronic registration will be available through the Google Form link: <https://forms.gle/m9KMxmOvVu8faAQK7>. Each association must submit an official list of their delegation's names no later than Friday, January 10, 2025.

Entry Visas

The Emirates Scout Association will handle the issuance of entry visas to the United Arab Emirates for all official members of the delegations participating in the gathering, free of charge, in accordance with the country's regulations. The following conditions must be met:

- Passports must be valid until at least October 1, 2025.
- Passport copies must be clear and complete, and personal photos must be sized 4×6 cm with a white background.
- Photos must be scanned using a scanner; mobile phone images will not be accepted.

Participation Requirements:

- **Age:** Participants (rovers) must be between 18 and 25 years old (born between February 8, 2000, and February 8, 2007).
- **Latin American Participants:** A document from the Interamerican Region must be attached, specifying pre-arranged visas for transit through Europe or America to issue travel tickets.
- **Travel Costs:**
 - The Emirates Scout Association (Sharjah Scout Mission) will cover travel costs for one (1) rover scout per NSO, up to a maximum of \$2,000 USD per participant.
 - If airfare exceeds the specified amount, the participant must book their ticket independently and will be reimbursed up to \$2,000 USD upon arrival in Sharjah.
- **Accommodation and Local Expenses:**
 - The Emirates Scout Association will cover accommodation, meals, and internal transportation for one rover scout from each participating NSO, based on regional quotas.
- **Additional Costs:** Any costs or fees incurred outside the program period (February 8–17, 2025) are the participant's responsibility.
- **Scout Uniform:** Participants must wear their full scout uniform during all official programs and upon arrival at airports for easier identification and reception.
- **Compliance:** Participants must adhere to all rules and regulations in the UAE.

Medical Fitness:

- Participants must be medically fit to engage in all activities requiring physical effort and free from chronic illnesses or seizures.
- A medical check-up must be conducted by each NSO, which must certify and take responsibility for the participant's health.

Accommodation:

- Participants will stay in tents provided by the Gathering organizers.
- Each participant must bring their own sleeping bag and mat.

Weather:

- During the gathering, the weather will be sunny during the day and cool at night, with expected temperatures ranging from 16°C to 24°C.
- Since the camping site is in an open area, participants must bring warm clothing, especially for nighttime (e.g., padded jackets and heavy trousers).
- Rain showers may occur during the gathering, so participants should bring a rain jacket.

Safety, Security, and Health Services

- The Gathering management will provide fire and rescue vehicles at the site.
- Medical care and services will be available 24/7 to address any emergency cases. Ambulances will be available to transfer critical cases to medical centers (excluding pre-existing conditions).
- Participants with chronic illnesses requiring medication must bring sufficient quantities and inform the Gathering organizers prior to the gathering.

Transportation to and from the Gathering

- Delegations arriving from outside the UAE will be received at any UAE airport and transported to the Gathering site. Similarly, transport will be arranged for departures. Participants are required to wear the official scout uniform upon arrival at the airport for easy identification and reception. All internal transportation during the Gathering program will be provided.

Safe from Harm

- Ensuring a safe environment for participants to engage in scouting activities is a priority. Measures will be taken to reduce bullying, physical abuse, emotional abuse, and exploitation.

- Participants over 18 years old must complete a "Safe from Harm" training and attach their certificate of completion (valid for no more than 4 months) with their registration form.

Souvenirs

- Each participant will receive gifts and souvenirs commemorating the Gathering.

Cultural and International Scout Gatherings

1. International Cultural Day

- As part of the gathering celebrations, an International Cultural Day will be held, providing participants the opportunity to exchange cultures and learn about the diverse traditions of the participating countries.
- The Gathering will include exhibitions featuring each country's traditions, showcasing local dishes, and highlighting cultural heritage. Participants are encouraged to wear their national costumes.
- Each delegation is required to bring the following:
 - National flag.
 - Printed materials highlighting cultural landmarks.
 - Samples of traditional foods.
 - Folklore or traditional performances accompanied by national music.
 - National and scouting souvenirs.
- Each delegation will be assigned a table for their display.

2. International Exhibition

- To promote cultural diversity and encourage learning about the heritage, culture, and tourism of participating countries, an "International Exhibition" area will be allocated.
- This exhibition, often attended by the Gathering patron, allows participants to showcase their country's heritage, tourism, and scouting initiatives.
- Each country will be provided a tent (3x3 meters) with one display table (180x70 cm) and an electrical outlet. Delegations can use this opportunity to present their scouting and cultural heritage and create opportunities for exchange programs.

Gathering Services

The Gathering management will provide the following facilities:

- Communication and internet center.
- Media center for participating delegations.

- Gift and souvenir shops.
- Medical center with emergency services.
- Currency exchange services.
- Laundry and ironing facilities.
- Cafeteria.

National Flags

- Each participant must bring two (2) national flags measuring 80×120 cm to be handed over to the Gathering management upon arrival.
