The working language during the workshop will be English. Selected participants should be able to understand and actively participate in discussions in English.

Climate


The climate in Kuala Lumpur is usually mild throughout the year. The normal temperature in Malaysia in May ranges from 24°C to 35°C.

Time Zone

The local time in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, is Greenwich Mean Time (UTC/GMT +8:00 hours).

Electricity

The standard voltage in Malaysia is 230 volts (V) at 50 hertz (Hz), but it's often 240 V in practice. Malaysia uses plug type G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern.



Currency

The local currency is the Malaysian Ringgit (MYR). USD1.00 is approximately equal to about MYR4.44+- as of 26th March 2025. It is highly recommended that you change your US dollars at foreign exchange counter (banks like CIMB, Maybank) in Kuala Lumpur International Airport or have them exchanged from their respective country.

On your return

If participants have other plans after the workshop, they can only be dropped off at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KUL) from the Dorsett Grand Subang Hotel. From the airport, you may take the train or arrange your own local transport to travel around Malaysia
