Date	:	09 to 13 January 2026
Venue	:	Budhli, District: Balod, Chhattisgarh State, India
Theme	:	" DEVELOPED YOUTH, DEVELOPED NATION"
Eligibility Criteria	:	Senior Scouts and Guides (Class XI & XII), Rovers and Rangers aged 15 to 29 years are eligible to participate with Rover Scout Leader at a ratio of 9:1. Young Wood Badge Holder under 35 years of age are also eligible to participate as a part of the NSO Contingent.
Registration Fee	:	USD \$150.00 fee includes Lodging, boarding & Event Souvenir, Educational Tour and inland Transportation from International Airport Raipur to Jamboree site and Back. The fee can be paid during registration at the Jamboree site. (Meals will be served from Breakfast of 09.01.2026 to Lunch of 13.01. 2026)

How to Reach	:	By Air: Swami Vivekananda International Airport, Raipur. The distance from Raipur Airport to the Jamboree site is approximately 112 K.M. By Train: 24x7 Transportation Information Centers: To facilitate smooth travel for all participants, Transportation Information Centers will operate round-the-clock at the following key locations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rajnandgaon Railway Station.• Durg Railway Station• Raipur Railway Station. These centers will assist Jamboree participant with directions, transportation options, and other logistics required to reach the Jamboree site efficiently. Date of Departure	:	All the participants will be relived from the Jamboree site on 13 th January 2026 afternoon.
